This past year, Foothill Family celebrated our 95th year of serving this community and empowering families. Grown from a grassroots effort in Pasadena in 1926 to an organization serving nearly 20,000 individuals and families in 2020-2021, Foothill Family's 95th anniversary marks more than a milestone. It underscores the ongoing crucial need for services that improve the emotional well-being of children and families and supports healthy early childhood development allowing all those we encounter to meet a multitude of challenges facing many in our community. Foothill Family's more than nine decades of growth and evolution have been a testament to the proficiency and agility in responding to a complex, shifting landscape, especially these past two years with the COVID-19 Pandemic

Foothill Family's diverse staff continue to do a remarkable job providing services with the high-quality, personalized, and dignified approach that has been our hallmark from the start. This stellar team has been innovative in adapting the way we provide services as the pandemic continues to impact all aspects of life . Whether they are teaching and coaching parents to contribute to their child's social-emotional development; supporting families through a life transition or traumatic chapter; or providing services aimed at prevention, intervention, or treatment, this team is helping parents and children thrive, together.

Looking forward, we are focused on growing our services to meet the needs in the many communities we serve, including an increased presence in Pomona at a new permanent location. Now in the fourth year of our five-year strategic plan, we are moving forward with the last phase of our three-phase expansion that saw centers successfully open in Duarte (2018) and Covina (2020). This third and final phase involves purchasing a 10,000 square foot center in Pomona that will offer early childhood development programs, youth & family services, and vital community resources.

The commitment of our Board of Directors, our Advisory Board, and our volunteer group, the Friends of Foothill Family, add markedly to advance Foothill Family's mission and provide the community leadership that is essential to our impact and future growth. The advances we have achieved at Foothill Family would not be possible without the advocacy of these crucial champions, as well as the strategic partnerships we have established with our generous individual, corporate, and foundation donors.



For more than 95 years, Foothill Family has led the way in providing comprehensive mental health and social services throughout the San Gabriel and Pomona Valleys, Glendale, and Burbank, through the following key programmatic areas:



Mental Health Care

Foothill Family provides effective mental health assessment and treatment for children and adults, individuals and families.

Early Childhood Development

Foothill Family's zero to five programs provide parents/caregivers and their young, high-needs children with essential early intervention, detection, and prevention strategies and tools during their child's critical developmental years. Services include parent education and can address autism spectrum disorder and/or other developmental delays.

School-Based Services

Currently providing services in 18 school districts in Southern California,
Foothill Family provides assistance to children and youth exhibiting social and/or emotional challenges in order for them to succeed at school, at home, and in their communities.

Our programs include teacher trainings and promote school community development alongside school/family engagement.

Youth & Family Services

Foothill Family launches families on healthy journeys by providing mental health treatment for children and their caregivers, as well as treatment and support services for victims of abuse, neglect, and/or domestic violence. Also, case management and mentoring programs help pregnant and/or parenting youth to attend school and graduate, raise healthy babies, and learn positive parenting skills.




